

CISTERN



Located inside the walled stronghold that protected the city, it is considered one of the most notable urban cisterns of the medieval period (13th -14th centuries).

ARCHAEOLOGICAL CENTER

It is the most important archaeological ensemble discovered in Lamego that illustrates the city's dynamic transformation over more than two thousand years of its history, from the Roman period to the present day, including important remains of a medieval cemetery.



CASTLE



The castle, National Monument, has been documented since the 10th century, a period in which the Douro Valley was disputed by Christian and Muslim forces and culminated in the final "christian reconquest" of the city by Fernando Magno, in 1057. Land of King, had its forum be handed over to the Coutinhos lineage in the mid-century XIV, (who built their palaces there).

ALMACAVE CHURCH

Romanesque monument from the 12th century where the legendary "Cortes de Lamego" took place in 1143.



St. FRANCISC CHURCH



Church of the former Convent of St. Francis that was raised in 1559. After a fire it underwent major changes. Inside, it is worth highlighting an image of Our Lady (16th century) carved in wood.

UNKNOWN SOLDIER MEMORIAL

Statue of the Unknown Soldier in memory of the dead of World War I, it was built in 1932.
